The 25th Annual All Academy Golf Challenge will bring graduates, parents, guests and friends of the U. S. Military, Naval, Coast Guard, Merchant Marine and Air Force Academies together for their annual gathering and contest to claim the Challenge Trophy. The Ken Kronlund Classic is open to all ROTC Graduates and Cadets as well as all military, veterans and friends.

The West Point Society of New England sponsors this event to support a great cause, "Honor Flight, New England". Shotgun start begins promptly at 0900. Registration opens at 0730.

## FORMAT:

Two-person teams will choose one of the following formats of play for their team.

Nine holes of scramble and nine holes of best ball, declared hole by hole by each team after both golfers on the team have hit their tee shots.

Best Ball for all 18 holes. (team is awarded bonus points).

Scramble for all 18 holes. (team will have penalty points deducted)

1. The ALL ACADEMY CHALLENGE TROPHY is limited to teams consisting of graduates of the same academy.
2. The KEN KRONLUND CLASSIC OPEN TROPHY, INDIVIDUAL CHAMPION TROPHY and all other competitions and recognitions are available to all players. THE CHALLENGE TROPHY AND OPEN TROPHY will recognize the winning team and runner up.
3. The 2017 KEN KRONLUND CLASSIC INDIVIDUAL CHAMPION TROPHY will be awarded to the player scoring the most points playing Best Ball format.
4. Cost is \$150 for each player, which includes: buffet lunch, green fees, cart, prizes and one restricted mulligan. Unrestricted mulligans may be purchased on line during registration.

The club house will be serving beverages at the bar and on the course (cash - no host).

# HONOR FLIGHT NEW ENGLAND

Honor Flight New England joined with the national organization Honor Flight Network in the Spring of 2009, and is a non-profit organization dedicated to honoring America's most senior veterans. Through generous donations, we transport our heroes to Washington, D.C., to visit and reflect at their memorials AT NO COST TO THE VETERAN. Top priority is currently given to the WWII Veterans, along with those other veterans who may be terminally ill. Beginning in the Spring of 2016, Honor Flight New England will also begin transporting Korean War Veterans. With approximately 500 WWII Veterans dying each day, and many Korean War Veterans not being far behind in age, our time to express our thanks to these brave men and women is running out.

Our first flight was on June 13, 2009. It was a humbling experience to be with these Veterans on our maiden voyage to D.C. Of those 50 Veterans and Guardians traveling with us, on board were 14 WWII II Prisoners of War and 5 World War II Heroes, including one hero that lost his sight while serving his country.

Honor Flight New England has learned a lot over these last six years, most notably that our veteran heroes aren't asking for recognition. It is our position that they deserve it. Our program is just a small token of our appreciation for those that gave so much. Please help us continue to make their dream of visiting THEIR memorials a reality.
